



Kia ora parents, whānau and caregivers.

It is fantastic to see our school numbers bounce back up towards our normal attendance levels. We expect all students back at school at the start of Term 2, unless they are isolating due to being a household contact, a positive COVID case or are unwell.

Student Behaviour

This week we have met with a small number of students to address some concerns we have around student behaviour. Every student has the right to feel safe and be safe at Tauranga Intermediate. This includes travelling to and from school on the bus or by foot. All teachers have the right to be treated with respect. When we look at our concerning behaviours, we are dealing with 3 – 4% of our student population. We are putting in a lot of effort and resources to support these students and to ensure they are making positive choices. A reminder, If your child has any concerns, they should let their classroom teacher know.

Teacher Only Day:

A reminder that next Thursday 14th April, is a Teacher Only Day. This means the last day of Term 1 for students is Wednesday 13th April, as it is the Good Friday, Easter holiday on Friday 15th April. .

Winter Uniform:

A reminder that in Terms 2 and 3, students are to wear plain black lace up polishable shoes. Boys are to wear our Tauranga Intermediate School socks and girls have the choice of navy ankle or medium length socks, or navy tights. Students are to wear our TIS navy fleece jersey and have the option of purchasing our TIS raincoat. No non-uniform jackets and hoodies are to be worn at school.

The report also includes a General Comment and a Technology Specialist report. Our Technology Specialist classes run throughout the year and include Science, Art, Soft Materials, Hard Materials, Food, Music and Digital Technology. The report will be sent home with your child on Monday 23rd May.

Learning Conferences

Our Learning Conferences are an opportunity for you and your child to meet with their teacher and share learning, progress, challenges, goals, and achievements. Learning Conferences are being held on Wednesday 25th May (3:30pm - 6:30pm) and Thursday 26th May (8:00am - 7:00pm).

Each conference includes 15mins with the teacher and 15mins for whānau to be together to explore their child's learning in class. Bookings can be made using the School Interviews website.
